PDDM celebrates 35th Death anniversary of the Co-foundress, Mother Scholastica

24th March remains a remarkable day for the Sister Disciples of the Divine Master as we celebrate the 35th Death anniversary of our first Mother and Co-Foundress Venerable Scholastica Rivata who was born on 12 July 1897 at Guarene, Italy to Lucia Alessandria and Antonio Rivata and baptized Ursula. At the early age of six her mother died of illness but Ursula was well prepared to live the consecrated life. The first 'yes' sprang from her First Holy Communion. But for various reasons, the hour of God was manifested much later. At the age of 20, she received an enticing marriage proposal; however, she felt strongly drawn to respond to her calling in the following words: *Lord, You alone are enough!*

Ursula's encounter with Father Alberione [the Founder] was decisive in terms of her future life and mission. On 21 November 1923 Father Alberione selected two young women - Ursula Rivata and Metilda Gerlatto and set them apart for the project which was as yet unknown. He gave them the clear draft of a New Rule of life based on the adoration and the inseparable elements of hidden sacrifice of silence; he gave them this order "*Observe silence, silence*" - as if to say, you must listen, listen to the Lord's message. The presence speaking to us is not found in the earthquake, not in the fire but in the murmur of a light breeze, in silence (cf 1 Kings 19: 11-12).

At the beginning of the following year, i.e. on 10 February 1924 the founder gave life to a new institute, the Pious Disciples of the Divine Master. On 25 March 1924, the feast day of the Annunciation of Mary, Ursula took her first vows and received the name of Sister Scholastica and was assigned as the first Mother of the institute. In her letter she writes to the Founder, 'This time I have given all to Jesus. I offer him my body, my health, my soul, my intelligence.... Desires, affections, sentiments, food, sleep, miseries, sins... these and if ever there is something else which I do not know I give them all unconditionally. I am stripped of everything. I am made lighter for an absolute and total emptiness. I ask him to fill me up and clothe me of himself and to live only of, for, in him, my Master, shepherd, spouse and saviour and to able to act more freely in me with his design of love'.

Mother Scholastica was deeply drawn to the Holy Eucharist sustained by the queen of heaven, to whom she raised many rosaries. Mother Scholastica directed her entire life towards the tabernacle, towards Jesus Host, whom she adored with much faith, with whom she often dialogued, to whom she offered much. Her greatest comfort was to remain in the church, the sweetest place where Jesus nurtures us with joy. She also knew how to find the master outside of the chapel in the most significant events of the day. The most beautiful flower of the theological virtues blossomed in her thirst for souls for whom she prayed and suffered. "I will strive each day to become a disciple evermore in accordance with the desire of my Divine Master and Mary most Holy, to live in their life in an intense Eucharistic, Priestly, Liturgical apostolate which encompasses my entire being, mind, heart, will and energy".

In fulfilling her delicate mission of leadership, Mother Scholastica faced and overcame periods of humiliation and trials. But with faith, much prayer, and heroic silence, she fearlessly upheld the ideals of the Sister Disciples. She was well known for her faith, courage, love for priests and radiant smile which brought joy to many. She writes to her co-Sisters, "Have courage, this is nothing, it is simply one of the trials that Jesus grants us because he loves us, calm comes after the storm and the stronger the hurricane the greater the serenity".

In 1981 she landed in the house of Sanfre as the last shore of her earthly pilgrimage. Her last years on earth were an autumn of golden sunsets, the final stage of her ascension to God. Particularly, the last 6 years of her

life were turned more towards eternal realities than those that were passing. During this period of her life Mother Scholastica's voice began to gradually fail, leading to absolute silence, as if living to the depths the initial command given by the Founder: "Keep silence, silence, silence".

On 24 March 1987 she was still able to assist with sufficient alertness in the Vigil Mass of the Annunciation and receive a small sip of the consecrated blood; then at 7.15 pm, during the First Vespers of the Solemnity, the Blessed Virgin came to bring her beautiful soul into the kingdom of light. Chosen as the first Sister Disciple she sought to transform herself increasingly more into a flower of purity, of charity, of humility, of faith to fulfil the Pauline program 'mini vivere Christus' (Christ lives in me). While maintaining the freshness of her beautiful soul she pronounced her final yes on earth in characteristic silence, ready and adorned to celebrate the Eternal Wedding with the Divine Master.

Mother scholastic has left behind the beautiful legacy of life. She was a woman of without degrees or diplomas but with wisdom drawn daily at the font of the Eucharist she dedicated all her energies for the love of the congregation and glory of God.

The third woman is none other than our Blessed Mother who through her 'PERFECT YES' in the Annunciation brought forth the salvation of humankind. This perfect Disciple continues to accompany us in our constant striving to mature as committed Disciples. May we hold on to this Loving Mother in our walk as Women, Mothers, and Disciples.
